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I. Product Description

Andy Fluor 647-X-dUTP is supplied as 1 mM solution in TE buffer. The nucleotide is designed for enzymatic non-radioactive labeling of DNA by PCR, nick-translation, cDNA synthesis, random primed labeling, or primer extension. Andy Fluor 647-X-dUTP can be enzymatically incorporated into DNA with Reverse Transcriptases, *Taq* DNA Polymerase, phi29 DNA Polymerase, Klenow Fragment, exo-, Klenow Fragment, and DNA Polymerase I. The X linker between Andy Fluor 647 and dUTP can improve the incorporation efficiency.
